ABOUT AZERBAIJAN

AZERBAIJAN is often called the "Land of Fire," a nickname it has known since antiquity. The word Azerbaijan means 'Protector of Fire'. This natural fire, known as Yanar Dağ, has been blazing in Azerbaijan for at least 65 years. One of Azerbaijan's most famous sites is Yanar Dağ (or "Burning Mountain"), a natural glowing fire burning on a hillside along the Caspian Sea. It is home to some of the world's most enviable gas and oil fields, nearly half of the world's mud volcanoes, Ateshgah Zoroastrian Fire Temple. The country is abundant in oil and natural gas, it was a centre of fire worshipping and fire has always been one of the symbols of its capital Baku, which today is reflected in the amazing Flame Towers.



Azerbaijan, which is a developing country, located at the crossroads of Eastern Europe and Western Asia, is emerging as a compelling destination for global events. It is a part of the South Caucasus region and is bounded by the Caspian Sea to the east, Russia's Republic of Dagestan to the north, Georgia to the northwest, Armenia and Turkey to the west, and Iran to the south.

Azerbaijan was the first Muslim-majority country to become a democracy by declaring its independence from Russia. Fueled by the women's suffrage movement across many European countries, it also became the first Muslim nation and one of the first nations across the world to grant voting rights to women.

Azerbaijan was an independent nation from 1918 to 1920 but was then incorporated into the Soviet Union. It became a constituent (union) republic in 1936. Azerbaijan declared sovereignty on September 23, 1989, and independence on August 30, 1991. The vast majority of the country's population (97%) is nominally Muslim, but the constitution does not declare an official religion, and all major political forces in the country are secular. The





New Azerbaijan Party has been in charge since 1993, led by President Heydar Aliyev and his son Ilham Aliyev.

India and Azerbaijan have friendly relations and growing bilateral cooperation based on civilizational linkages, cultural affinities, and shared values of understanding and respect for other cultures. Azerbaijan is experiencing rapid economic growth, particularly in the logistics and transport sectors. The government is actively investing in infrastructure development and promoting business opportunities, making it an attractive destination for industry professionals.

Food tourism in Azerbaijan indulges in unique regional specialties, including fresh dairy products and mouthwatering sweets washed down with a delicate glass of tea.

ABOUT BAKU

Baku, the capital and commercial hub of Azerbaijan, is a city rich in history, culture, and modern development. Baku derives its importance from its oil industry and its administrative functions. The first historical reference to Baku dates from 885 CE, although archaeological evidence indicates a settlement there several centuries before Christ.

Baku is situated on the western coast of the Caspian Sea. It has a semi-arid climate with mild, wet winters and hot, dry summers.







Baku has a history that spans several millennia. It has been an important trade and cultural center due to its strategic location along the Silk Road. The city's Old Town, known as Icherisheher, is a UNESCO World Heritage site and features historic architecture like the Maiden Tower and the Palace of the Shirvanshahs. Contemporary landmarks include the Zaha Hadid–designed Heydar Aliyev Center, and the Flame Towers, 3 pointed skyscrapers covered with LED screens. Baku boasts striking modern architecture, including the Flame Towers, which are designed to resemble flames and are illuminated at night.

The Heydar Aliyev Center, designed by Zaha Hadid, is another architectural marvel known for its flowing,

futuristic design. Major attractions in Baku include the Baku Boulevard along the Caspian Sea, the futuristic buildings in the city center, and the Flame Towers. The city's mix of modernity and tradition makes it an interesting destination for travelers.

Overall, Baku is a city where ancient traditions coexist with modern advancements, offering a unique experience for residents and visitors alike.

FOOD & CUISINE

In Baku, the cuisine reflects Azerbaijan's rich cultural heritage, blending Middle Eastern, Persian, and Turkish influences with unique local flavors. CULTURE

Cultural expressions are evident in Baku's festivals, music, and cuisine, while public spaces like the Caspian Sea Boulevard and the UNESCO-listed Old Town highlight its historical depth and modern growth. This fusion creates a unique cultural atmosphere that celebrates both its storied past and its progressive spirit.

CLIMATE

Baku experiences a semi-arid climate characterized by mild, wet winters and hot, dry summers. Located on the western shore of the Caspian Sea, the city benefits from a relatively moderate temperature range, though summer



temperatures can soar above 30°C (86°F). Rainfall is infrequent but more common during the winter months, while the summer is largely dry with plenty of sunshine. The city's climate is also influenced by the surrounding Absheron Peninsula, which can lead to occasional strong winds. Overall, Baku's climate provides a pleasant environment for outdoor activities and exploring the city year-round. In early December, Baku experiences cool and relatively mild weather with temperatures typically ranging between 8°C to 15°C (46°F to 59°F). The weather is generally pleasant for exploring the city, though it can be windy due to the city's coastal location. Overall, early December in Baku offers a cool,

crisp climate suitable for sightseeing and outdoor activities.





SHOPPING

Shopping in Baku offers a diverse and vibrant experience, blending traditional bazaars with modern retail spaces. The city features a mix of luxury boutiques, international brands, and local markets. Popular shopping destinations

include the upscale Port Baku Mall and the Ganjlik Mall, which host a range of high-end and mainstream retailers. For a more traditional experience, the Taza Bazaar and Yashil Bazaar provide a lively atmosphere where visitors can find fresh produce, spices, and handcrafted goods. The city is also known for its vibrant arts and crafts scene, with opportunities to purchase Azerbaijani carpets, jewelry, and traditional souvenirs. Heydar Aliyev International Airport is one of the seven international airports serving Azerbaijan. It is the busiest airport both in Azerbaijan and in the South Caucasus as well as one of the busiest in the post-Soviet countries. It is about 24 km from the city centre, and you can easily find airport taxis and rental cars around the airport. The time and distance between GYD airport and Convention Hotel Mariott Boulevard is 30 mins (23.8 kms).

DELEGATE FEE

Due to the availability of direct flights between Mumbai (BOM) and Delhi (DEL) to Baku, we have prepared package fees for accommodations of 3 nights and 4 nights. **DELEGATES MAY SELECT ANY ONE OF THE PACKAGES BETWEEN THE 3-NIGHT AND 4-NIGHT PACKAGES, ACCORDING TO THEIR PREFERENCE.**

I). DELEGATE PACKAGE FEE FOR 3 NIGHTS:

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations done on or before 10th October 2024 shall be subject to a deduction of 25% of the delegate fee, and cancellations from 11th October to 31st October 2024 shall be subject to a deduction of 50% of the delegate fee. No refund on cancellation done after 31st October 2024. Cancellation of Hotel room booking is subject to heavy penalties on ACAAI.





AIRPORT TRANSFERS

The time of travel taken from Heydar Aliyev International Airport (GYD) to Hotel Marriott Baku Boulevard is approximately 45 mins to 1 hour.

- Transport from Airport to Convention hotel shall be provided by ACAAI to the registered delegates on 4th &

All Business Sessions and all other official functions including hosted events are for registered delegates and their spouses and for those invited by the ACAAI Managing Committee.





ACAAI does not encourage participation of children below 18 years of age and they will not be allowed to attend any official function including lunches, cocktails, and dinners. Kindly note this to avoid any last-minute embarrassment.

SPOUSES PROGRAMME (only for spouses of the registered delegates)

Spouses of the registered delegates staying at the Convention hotel shall register for spouse tour which will be on 6th December 2024. However, the registration for this spouse tour should be done at the ACAAI Registration Desk on 5th December 2024.


